### Applications

A new LVN class begins every 18 months. When the program begins in the Fall semester, applications must be received by 5:00 pm, March 31. When the program begins in the Spring semester, applications must be received by 5:00 pm, August 31 (Postmarks will not be accepted). Applications will be available online and in the Nursing Office approximately four months before the application deadline. Reapplications will be available two months before the deadline.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Butte College Vocational Nursing program prepares the students for licensure as a vocational nurse. The curriculum consists of three academic semesters of nursing theory and supervised clinical experience.

### General Requirements

- Age 17 years or older.
- 12th grade education or equivalent.

### Selection Process

1. Prerequisite courses must be completed before applying to the program.
2. In the event that there are more qualified candidates than vacancies in the class, a computer lottery will select the individuals to be enrolled.
3. Applicants that are not selected for enrollment must reapply if they wish to be considered for admission to a future program. Odds of admission increase with each **consecutive** reapplication.

## PREREQUISITES FOR ENROLLMENT

### Qualification

Prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.

There is no recency requirement for prerequisite courses. Applicants are responsible for knowledge of the content presented in prerequisite courses regardless of when the courses were taken.

### Prerequisites

1. ENGL 2-Reading and Composition
2. MATH 108-Beginning Algebra or placement on Butte College Assessment Test Algebra I Level IV.
3. BIOL 20 - Human Anatomy (no online lab)
4. FN 2 - Basic Nutrition  
or FN 50 - Nutrition and Diet Therapy
5. BIOL 21 - Human Physiology (no online lab)
