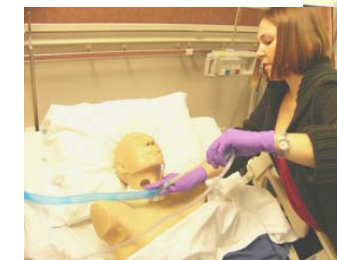

REQUIREMENTS FOR SELECTION FOR ENROLLMENT



General

- Age 17 years or older.
- Submission of a complete application.
- Physical and mental ability to safely perform the role of a Respiratory Therapist.

Academic

Courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. Work "in progress" will be accepted, pending final grade.

Selection Process

1. Prerequisite courses may be in progress at the time of application. However, priority for selection will be given to those candidates who have successfully completed all prerequisites prior to the application closing date.
2. In the event that there are more qualified candidates than vacancies in the class, a computer lottery will select the individuals to be enrolled.
3. Applicants that are not selected for enrollment will be placed on a wait list for the next program. However, wait listed applicants must reapply in order to be considered for priority admission to the next program.
