SELECTION PROCEDURE

Application Process

- Complete one-page Academy application
- Complete Butte College Enrollment Application
- Take P.O.S.T. Entry-Level Law Enforcement Examination
- Attend Academy Orientation
- Complete Personal History Statement
- Pass Medical Examination
- Obtain Criminal Clearance through Department of Justice
- Submit DMV Driving Record
- Pay Fees

Estimated Costs

- \$2,000 Enrollment
- \$550 Uniforms
- \$600 Ammunition
- \$100 Miscellaneous
- Laptop Computer

CERTIFICATION

Upon successful completion of the course, students will:

- Receive 35.5 semester units of college credit
- Be eligible to apply to entry level positions as a law enforcement officer in California
