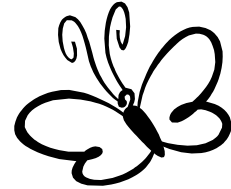

COMMON SENSE PARENTING: THE BOYS TOWN MODEL

A step-by-step guide to raising responsible kids and building happy families. In each class, time will be given to trouble shoot problem behaviors currently being experienced in the home.
