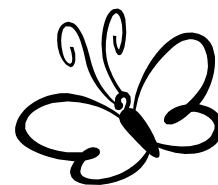

COMMON SENSE PARENTING: THE BOYS TOWN MODEL

A step-by-step guide to raising responsible kids and building happy families. In this six week course, parents are taught skills that help them encourage positive behavior, discourage negative behavior, and teach alternatives to problem behavior. In each class, time will be given to trouble shoot problem behaviors currently being experienced in the home.

May	23	Class 5/6	Teaching Self Control – Teaching and practicing acceptable alternatives
May	30	Class 6/6	Putting it all Together – Review and practice of all the skills learned
