



Butte College Foundation Scholarship List

The following scholarships are offered by Butte College Foundation. Our scholarship application period runs from the beginning of February - the second week of March each year. Most scholarship applications are available during this time; however certain departments or academies offer off-cycle scholarships at graduation. Check with the Foundation office for more detail. This is a general list of scholarships.

AAUW Assn American Women Frances Pence Scholarship

The Frances Pence scholarship was established by the American Association of University Women Paradise Branch and is awarded to full-time (12 units or more per semester) re-entry students whose studies were interrupted by at least two years and are returning to college. Students must have attended Paradise or Ridgeview High Schools.

Adopt A Student

These scholarship funds are donated by attendees of Butte College Foundation's Annual Spring Gala and are awarded to full-time students (minimum of 12 units) who will be receiving any form of financial aid.

Ag and Horticulture/Arena Funds

Established by the Butte College Foundation, this scholarship will assist students majoring in the agriculture or horticulture field who have maintained a minimum GPA of 2.5.

Ag and Natural Resources

Established by the Butte College Agricultural Faculty, scholarships are awarded to full-time (at least 12 units) students who are majoring in Agriculture, Natural Resources, or Environmental Horticulture. Students must be enrolled in or have completed at least two classes from the majors listed above.

Alta and Basil Gillett Memorial Scholarship

In memory of Basil Gillett, this scholarship will be awarded to a deserving student, preferably from Paradise, who has successfully completed at least 12 units at Butte College and has maintained a GPA of 2.5 or better.

Anonymous Scholarship

This scholarship was established by an anonymous family and is awarded to full-time students (at least 12) for community service involvement, and those in an honors program who maintain a GPA of 2.8 or better. The scholarship is intended for students planning to transfer to a four-year university or college.

Art Buckley Endowment Scholarship Fund

The purpose of the Art Buckley scholarship fund shall be to provide scholarships exclusively for students from Paradise High School, Ridgeview High School, and eLearning Academy of the Paradise Unified School District, including graduating, continuing, and re-entry students. Preference shall be given to students with financial need who are planning to transfer to Chico State or another four-year college or university.

Augie Merrill Memorial Scholarship

Created in memory of Augie Merrill, this scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled in the LVN or RN program with a minimum GPA of 3.0 or better. Preference shall be given to a student who has not previously received a higher education degree.

Auxiliary Services (Dining Services and/or Bookstore) & Pepsi Scholarship

This scholarship was established in conjunction with Auxiliary Services funds, as well as funds donated by Pepsi, and is awarded to a full-time or part-time student who is employed by Butte College Auxiliary Services (Dining Services and/or Bookstore), demonstrates financial need, and maintains a GPA of 2.5 or better.

Beta Sigma Phi Nursing Scholarship

This scholarship was established by Beta Sigma Phi Sorority in 2024 to assist Nursing students who are in their second year of training or will have completed their first semester in the Accelerated RN Program by the Fall, have a minimum of a cumulative 3.0gpa and demonstrate financial need. Financial Need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid.

Betty M. Forsberg Scholarship

This scholarship was created in honor of Betty Forsberg. The scholarship will be awarded to a nursing student who has a GPA of 3.0 or better and demonstrates financial need. Financial Need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid.

Blythe Family Scholarship

This scholarship was established in the name of former Foundation Board member Patrick Blythe, former executive director of Butte College Foundation. This scholarship is awarded to a student who graduated from Ridgeview High School in the Paradise Unified School District.

Bob Donohue Memorial State Park Ranger Scholarship

This scholarship was created in memory of Bob Donohue, Bidwell Park's first park ranger. This scholarship is awarded to an outstanding student in the State Parks Academy.

Briggs Family Scholarship

This scholarship was created in memory of Jack and Magdalena Briggs and is awarded to a full-time second year student with a minimum GPA of 2.5 who demonstrates financial need. Financial Need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid.

Brown Family Scholarship

The Brown Family Scholarship is awarded to a full-time or part-time student residing in Butte County.

Bruce McCulloch Memorial-Allied Health

In memory of Bruce McCulloch, this scholarship is awarded to a full-time student that has completed at least one biology class and is pursuing a degree in Allied Health. Students are selected by the biology department.

Bruce McCulloch Memorial-Biology

In memory of Bruce McCulloch, this scholarship is awarded to a full-time student that has completed at least one biology class and is pursuing a degree in Biology. Students are selected by the biology department.

Brunner Family Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to students based on GPA and community leadership and involvement.

Bryan K. Zollner Memorial Scholarship

Applicants must have successfully completed all requirements for graduation from the Butte College Fire Academy, demonstrate academic performance with a minimum GPA of 2.5 or higher and demonstrate financial need.

Butte College Employee Memorial Scholarship

Established by the Butte College Foundation in memory of Butte College Employees who have passed, these scholarships are awarded to full-time (at least 12 semester units) students who maintain a GPA of 3.0 and demonstrate scholastic achievement and an interest in community volunteerism.

Butte College Foundation General Scholarship

Established by the Butte College Foundation, this scholarship is awarded to full time students (12 or more units) who maintain a GPA of 3.2 or higher and are involved in community leadership.

Butte-Glenn College Trustees Scholarship

Established by the Butte College Board of Trustees, this scholarship is awarded to a full-time student (at least 12 units) who has completed at least 24 units of college level units, maintained a GPA of 2.8 or above, plans to transfer to a four-year institution, and demonstrates community leadership and activism.

Byron Thomas Memorial Scholarship

In memory of Byron Thomas, this scholarship is awarded to a full-time or part-time student pursuing a Music Degree with a minimum GPA of 2.5.

Charles & Scott Perry Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Charles and Scott Perry and is awarded to a full-time student in the MESA/STEM program with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Preference shall be given to applicants who are not receiving other existing scholarship support.

Chet Lyssy Memorial Scholarship

Established in 2021, the Chet Lyssy Memorial Scholarship was created in honor of Chet Lyssy, a former Butte College Tennis coach and Hall of Famer. This scholarship is awarded to students that have a 3.0GPA with an interest in athletics.

Christian Woods Memorial Scholarship

Established by the family in memory of Christian Woods, the Christian Woods Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled in the Fire Academy, maintain a minimum of a 2.0 GPA. Preference shall be given to a Butte County resident or re-entry student.

Christopher & Jean Covell Scholarship Endowment

In honor of Jean Covell and Christopher Covell, this scholarship is awarded to a full-time student enrolled in the Fire Academy.

Classified Senate - Transfer Student Scholarship

This scholarship is funded by the Classified Senate and is awarded to a student transferring to a four-year school on a full-time basis who has maintained a cumulative GPA of 2.5. Proof of acceptance to a 4-year school is required along with evidence of some community service. This scholarship is awarded to a student who will be receiving any form of financial aid.

Classified Senate-Voc/Tech. Ed. Scholarship

This scholarship is funded by the Classified Senate and awarded to a full-time student with a minimum GPA of 2.5. Students must be enrolled in a specific program: * Automotive * Agriculture * Industrial * Nursing * Welding * or any Certificated Program. This scholarship is awarded to a student who will be receiving any form of financial aid.

Dale Ott Scholarship

This scholarship was established by 2021 Outstanding Alumnus Dale Ott and is awarded to full or part-time students in any major.

Daniel J. Moriarty Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship honors the memory of Daniel J. Moriarty and is awarded to a full-time Butte College student with demonstrated academic performance. This scholarship is awarded to a student who will be receiving any of the following for financial assistance: Federal Pell Grant, Cal Grant, or Chafee Grant. Preference is given in the following order: incoming freshmen who graduated from Ridgeview High School in Paradise, continuing students who are graduates of Ridgeview, graduates of Paradise High School or Paradise eLearning Academy, and graduates from any high school in Butte of Glenn counties.

Danny C. Meyer Scholarship

The Danny C. Meyer Scholarship is awarded to a student in their second semester of the automotive program. The student must be enrolled in 12 units and maintain a minimum of a 2.0 GPA.

David Mobilio Memorial Scholarship

Established by family and friends in memory of Peace Officer David Mobilio, this scholarship is awarded to Law Enforcement Academy full-time student that have successfully completed all requirements for graduation and demonstrated superior leadership.

Davies Family Scholarship

This Davies Family Endowment was established to offer scholarships to re-entry students majoring in Agriculture or Horticulture who reside in Butte County, demonstrate financial need, and have maintained a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Dean's Scholarship

This scholarship was created by past Deans and Directors of Butte College and is awarded to a full-time student with a GPA of 3.5 or better. Student must demonstrate financial need, volunteer work, community service and participation. The student must have completed 15 units of courses 1-199 and be majoring in a career or technical education program or transfer general education program.

Director's Scholarship

The Director's scholarship is awarded to a part-time (at least 6 units) or full-time (at least 12 units) student who is maintaining a GPA of 2.75 or above and resides in the counties of Butte or Glenn.

Donna Lenhoff Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Donna Lenhoff and is awarded to a full-time student who has graduated from Oroville High School. Students must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and demonstrate financial need. Financial Need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid.

Dorothy Kincade Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a student in the nursing program who has maintained a GPA of 3.0 and who will be receiving any of the following for financial assistance: Federal Pell Grant, Cal Grant, or Chafee Grant. LVNs must be in their second semester. RNs and LVNs to ADNs must be in clinical.

Doug Flesher Memorial Scholarship

In memory of Doug Flesher, a long serving Butte College instructor, member of the Butte College Foundation Board, and a community volunteer, this scholarship is awarded to a full-time Agriculture student (12 units or more) with a GPA of 2.5 or more who resides in Butte County.

Ed Craddock Scholarship

Established by Ed Craddock, this scholarship assists students in an A.S. degree program enrolled in either the Agricultural Sciences, Natural Resources, Physical Sciences, Biological Sciences, or Engineering programs. The recipient must have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Preference shall be given to students interested in pursuing a career in water management and resource conservation. The scholarship is only awarded while attending Butte College, but the recipient should be planning on transferring to a four-year university or college.

Edna F. Desmond Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Edna F. Desmond to assist re-entry students (students who attended college in the past and are returning to further their education) who are enrolled full-time (at least 12 units) and maintain a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA. Student must be pursuing an English, Business, or Office Administration major and demonstrate financial need. Financial need is determined by students who will be receiving any form of financial aid.

Education Without Borders Scholarship

Established by educators Brad and Yvette Zuniga, The Education Without Borders Scholarship is awarded to students who demonstrate leadership in issues that affect undocumented communities and further championing for free immigration.

Emmett H. Ashley/R.F. MacDonald Scholarship

This scholarship was created by the R.F. MacDonald Company to honor their former employee, Emmett H. Ashley. Emmett started his career with R.F. MacDonald Co. in 1983 as the 1st boilermaker/pressure vessel repair welder in the company and was instrumental in developing their quality control program. In 2001 he relocated to Fresno to assist with the development of apprentice boilermakers and in 2008 moved to the role of aftermarket sales specialist. This scholarship is dedicated to Emmett and his devotion to the company, his support of the industry, and his persistence in taking care of customers.

The scholarship will be awarded to a student who is enrolled in the Welding Technology program taking at least 12 units or more, maintaining a GPA of 3.0 and demonstrates financial need. Financial need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid.

Empathy Therapy Scholarship Endowment

This scholarship, established by Empathy Therapy, supports students facing financial hardship who have demonstrated a commitment to the LGBTQIA+ community or other underserved groups.

Ernie Kirker Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established to assist full or part-time students (at least 6 units) who are majoring in the Arts or are actively involved in fine arts classes at Butte College and who demonstrate talent and potential.

Faculty & Staff Scholarship

Established and supported by Faculty and Staff of Butte College, this scholarship is awarded to full-time students who reside in Butte or Glenn Counties. Students must maintain a 2.5 GPA and demonstrate financial need.

Faith in the Future Scholarship

The Faith in the Future Scholarship was established to assist full time (12 or more units) students with greater than a 2.75 GPA. Students must be graduates of Gridley High School and reside in Gridley, CA.

Farshad Azad Social Justice Scholarship

This scholarship was established by Farshad Azad to be awarded to full-time students (at least 12 units) who have the desire to make social justice a priority in their lives and want to make a difference in their communities by displaying a commitment to addressing issues of social justice as servant leaders or as scholars. Social justice issues include civil rights, poverty, racism, income and opportunity inequality, equal justice, immigration, environment, education, and more.

Fern T. and Leo T. Barceloux Memorial Scholarship

The Fern T. and Leo T. Barceloux Memorial scholarship shall be offered to applicants registered in a minimum of 12 units of semester hours at Butte College with a grade point average of at least 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale). First preference shall be given to graduates of Orland High School. Secondary preference shall be given to graduates of any other Glenn County High School.

Foor Foundation Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the Foor Foundation and is awarded to full or part-time students who maintain a GPA of 2.5 and reside in Plumas, Tehama, Glenn or Butte Counties who demonstrate financial need and are interested in improving the environment.

Franklin & Virginia Murphy

The Franklin and Virginia Murphy Scholarship is awarded to a full-time student (at least 12 units) pursuing a career in the medical field: Nursing, EMT/Paramedic, Respiratory Therapy/Care, who is maintaining satisfactory academic progress (2.0 GPA or better). Preference will be given to residents of Oroville, CA.

Geoffrey and Dorothy Fricker Memorial Art Scholarship

In honor of Geoffrey and Dorothy Fricker, this scholarship is awarded to a student pursuing a degree and career in the Arts who will be taking at least six units at Butte College.

Gorrill Ranch Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a student majoring in Agriculture. The donor of this award will want to meet the recipient at Gorrill Ranch.

Grossman Family Scholarship

Established by the Grossman family, this scholarship is awarded to full-time students (at least 12 units) with a minimum GPA of 2.5 who are pursuing a career in the sciences or career technical education fields

Awarded to a newly enrolled or admitted full-time Butte College student who demonstrates financial need. Financial need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid. The recipient must be a graduate of Paradise High school and enrolled in a degree granting program. GPA must be 2.5 or better.

Haley McMahan Memorial Scholarship

In memory of Haley McMahan, this scholarship is offered to a full-time student (at least 12 units per semester) pursuing a registered nursing degree who resides in Butte County and has maintained a GPA of 2.5.

Hannie Voyles Memorial Scholarship Endowment

This scholarship was created in memory of Hannie Voyles. This scholarship is awarded to full time students that maintains a cumulative 3.0 GPA majoring in English and demonstrates financial need. Financial need is determined by students who will be receiving a form of financial aid.

Hannie was a long time Butte College instructor - over 30 years! Hannie said "I have some 5,000 students in the world whom I thank for making teaching so much fun! I never took a sick day! I never, never hated to go to work!"

At Butte College, Hannie was the department chair of 10 disciplines, Dean of Language Arts, Performing Arts, Humanities, the Learning Center; Field Hockey coach, which earned a state championship in 1978 and regional champions in years 1971-1979; and, she and a colleague started Butte College's Senior College at a time when Butte was "under enrolled" and added 2,000 senior students who enjoyed their experiences in a dozen different classes in both Butte and Glenn counties.

Hoyt Cutchen Memorial Scholarship

Established by Mrs. Linda Cutchen in memory of her husband, Hoyt, this scholarship is awarded to Law Enforcement Academy students that demonstrate financial need and reside in Butte County.

Jack L. Smith Memorial Scholarship

The [Jack L. Smith Memorial Scholarship](#), honoring the memory of Jack L. Smith, supports a full-time law enforcement academy student who embodies strong character.

Jane Rodgers Memorial Scholarship

Established in memory of Jane Rodgers, this scholarship is awarded to a Butte College student in this order: To a parent or sibling of a disabled child or adult or, if no one qualifies in this category, to a parent, preferably one in the Nutrition program.

Jason Watson Memorial

This scholarship is awarded to a fire academy student with financial need and a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Joel Belben and Dr. Laurel Hammang STEM Scholarship

This scholarship was established by two Outstanding Alumni who met while attending Butte College and is awarded to a full-time student in a STEM program with a 3.0 GPA or above.

John & Pat Jennings Memorial Scholarship

John A. McCurry Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established to assist a full-time Butte College re-entry student who maintains a 2.5 GPA, demonstrates financial need, and plans to transfer to CSU, Chico within one year. Financial need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid.

Jonathan M. Travis Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was created in memory of Jonathan M. Travis and is awarded to a full-time student (at least 12 units) pursuing a degree in the Drafting and CAD Technology Program.

Joshua Atteberry Memorial Scholarship

Established in memory of former student Joshua Atteberry, this scholarship is for students in the welding program.

Justin James May Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a fire academy student with financial need and a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Katherine & Hiram Petty Memorial Scholarship

In memory of Katherine and Hiram Petty, this scholarship is offered to a student maintaining a 2.5 GPA who is majoring in either Child Development or Natural Resources.

Kathy Lovelace Memorial Foster Youth Scholarship

Established in memory of Kathy Lovelace, this scholarship shall be awarded to full-time students (at least 12 units) who maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher who are Foster Youth.

Kenneth J. Baker Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was set up by the Baker Family in memory of Ken Baker and is awarded to a full-time student who has an interest in Anthropology, maintains a minimum 3.6 GPA or better, and has completed at least 12 units of college course work.

Keri Lynn Ank Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Keri Lyn Ank and is awarded to a full-time student who is majoring in Anthropology or Archeology or enrolled in Anthropology classes. Students must be U.S citizen maintaining a GPA of 3.0 or better.

Kurt Brown Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was created in memory of Kurt Brown and is awarded to a student with a 3.0 or greater GPA enrolled in Architecture, Engineering, Construction Management or Drafting, CAD Technology Major, Biology, Ag mechanics, Agribusiness, Ag Business Operations, Applied Horticulture/Operations, Crop Production, Welding, Fire Science.

Lake Oroville Area Garden Club

The Lake Oroville Area Garden Club Scholarship is awarded to a full-time Butte College student who resides in Butte County, has completed at least one semester of college and is majoring in Horticulture.

Lance Utterback Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is for students completing the Law Enforcement Academy with a GPA of 3.0 or better.

Langen Scholarship

This scholarship was established to support a student who is pursuing a nursing degree and is maintaining a minimum GPA of 3.0 or better.

Larry Cabral Memorial Scholarship

The recipient must major in Astronomy, Chemistry, Geology, Meteorology, or Physics with a minimum overall GPA of 3.0. Applicants must have completed a minimum of 15 units at Butte College. Service to the department such as tutoring, grading, or stockroom assistant will be looked upon favorably.

Laura & Jeanette Memorial Scholarship Endowment

The Laura and Jeanette Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a first-generation college student enrolled in fashion or the arts.

Lauren Scheall Memorial Nursing Excellence Scholarship

The Lauren Scheall Memorial Nursing Excellence Scholarship is selected by the department chair to students graduating from nursing program.

Leonela Porras Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Leonela Porras and is awarded to full-time students (at least 12 units) who demonstrate financial need. Financial need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid. Eligible students must have taken a class or classes in Social Justice, Cultural Studies, Multicultural Studies, Chicano Studies, or Latin American Studies.

Levi and Eunice Bentz Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Levi and Eunice Bentz and is awarded to a full-time student majoring in Agriculture or Physical Science.

Louise A Hagedorn Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to graduates of Paradise High School or Paradise eLearning Academy who are entering Butte College for the first time. The successful applicants will be enrolled at Butte College with a minimum of 12 units and have a high school GPA of 2.5 or greater.

Lynn Neal Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is in memory of Lynn Neal is awarded to a full-time student majoring in Language Arts or Tourism & Travel who is maintaining a GPA of 2.0 or greater.

Marc Thompson Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established by Butte College Associated Students in Memory of Marc Thompson. This scholarship is to be awarded to a student who has the desire to make social justice a priority in their lives and want to make a difference in their communities by displaying a commitment to addressing issues of social justice. Margaret Desmond Hughes Scholarship

This scholarship honors retired instructor Margaret Hughes and is awarded to a full or part-time student majoring in Agriculture, Nursing, English, Language Arts, Theatre Arts, or Arts with a 3.0 GPA who demonstrates financial need. Financial need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid.

Mary Cecelia Boss Memorial Scholarship

Established in loving memory of former student Mary Cecelia Boss, this scholarship is awarded to a full-time student with the desire to become an elementary school teacher with a GPA of 2.5 or greater.

Matt and Billie Jackson Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a full-time student with a minimum 2.5 GPA who has demonstrated community/volunteer service and financial need. Financial need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid.

Matt Gorton Scholarship Endowment

This scholarship was established by Joan Gunterman in memory of Matt Gorton. The scholarship will be awarded to a student who has accumulated 31 or less college units in the Heavy Equipment Operator Technician Certificate of Achievement Program.

Michael Boyd Paramedic Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a full-time student in the paramedic program with preference to Sierra County residents.

Mike & Linda Dunbaugh Exemplary Peace Officer Scholarship

Full time student enrolled in the Law Enforcement Academy that demonstrates financial need and maintains a 3.0 or better. The strongest consideration given to those possessing the strongest ethics, highest values, straightest political sensitivities, and deepest understanding of their profession always comes first and being a peace officer is their life, not just their job.

"More Like Marla" Memorial Nursing Scholarship

Established in loving memory of Marla Conry, the "More Like Marla" Nursing Scholarship is awarded to full-time nursing students who maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Preference shall be given to re-entry students (those who are returning to college after an absence) and Butte County residents.

MSC Scholarship

The MSC scholarship was established by the Butte College Management/Supervisory/Confidential staff and is awarded to a student who has completed at least 12 units or more at Butte College and plans to enroll in at least 12 units in the upcoming fall semester. The successful applicant will have maintained a GPA of 2.5 or higher and will be able to demonstrate involvement in a leadership role or community service.

Nicolina Milani Memorial Scholarship

In memory of Nicolina Milani, this scholarship is awarded to a student pursuing a career in fashion merchandising who is enrolled in at least 6 or more college units.

Nord Supper Club Scholarship

The Nord Supper Club scholarship was established to be awarded to students who have graduated from Nord Country School for no less than four years. The student must be taking at least six units while maintaining a GPA of 2.75 or greater.

This scholarship is awarded to full-time students entering Butte College who are majoring in Agriculture, Natural Resource, or Environmental Horticulture.

Ohlson Scholarship

Established by the Ohlson Family, this scholarship is awarded to the student with the greatest need who attended one of the Oroville area high schools. This scholarship is awarded to a student who demonstrates financial need. Financial need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid.

Osher Scholars Award Scholarship

The Osher scholarship is established as part of the Osher Initiative for California Community College students and criteria include full or part-time Butte College students who are CA Promise Grant fee waiver recipients and have completed 24 units of degree applicable study. Disbursement of funds for part-time students will be pro-rated depending on the number of units enrolled.

Osher Scholars Award - Dan & Dawn Ostrander Scholarship

This scholarship was established by Mr. and Mrs. Dan Ostrander as part of the Osher Initiative for California Community Colleges. Criteria includes full or part-time Butte College students who are CA Promise Grant fee waiver recipients and have completed 24 units of degree applicable study. Disbursement of funds for part-time students will be pro-rated depending on the number of units enrolled.

Osher Scholars Award - Sierra Central Scholarship

This scholarship is established as part of the Osher Initiative for California Community Colleges. Criteria includes full or part-time Butte College students who are CA Promise Grant fee waiver recipients and have completed 24 units of degree applicable study. Disbursement of funds for part-time students will be pro-rated depending on the number of units enrolled. Other factors such as extracurricular activities, volunteer work experience, honors and awards, and leadership experience will be taken into consideration.

Paradise Garden Club Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the Paradise Garden Club to support second year Butte College students pursuing a career in Environmental Horticulture or a related field. The successful applicants must be Butte County residents in their second year or higher, maintaining a GPA of 3.0 or greater.

PEO Sisterhood Scholarship

The PEO Sisterhood Scholarship (Philanthropic Educational Organization) is awarded to a student who has maintained a 3.0 GPA, demonstrates financial need, and is returning to college after an absence of at least two or more years as a re-entry student.

Pete Peterson Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship honors Pete Peterson and is awarded to a student in a nursing program who has maintained a GPA of 2.5 and who demonstrates financial need. Financial need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid.

Queer Resource Center's Lavender Scholarship Endowment

The QRC Lavender scholarship shall be awarded to students who affirmatively support LGBTQIA+ individuals and the LGBTQIA+ community as a whole through volunteerism and educational goals. Please note this scholarship will prompt the applicant to answer further questions after completion of the General Application in order for the application to be considered. Duplicate answers already mentioned in the General Application can be included again when answering these specific questions.

R. Scott and Cindy Chalmers Family Scholarship

This scholarship was established to assist a full-time student who is a Butte County resident, who works part-time (10 hrs. per week), and has a minimum GPA of 2.5. This scholarship is awarded to a student who demonstrates financial need. Financial need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid.

Randal J Clark Memorial Scholarship

Established in memory of Randal Clark, this scholarship is awarded to a full-time Butte College student who is majoring in Agriculture and has a GPA of 2.0 or better. Preference is given to a student from Mendocino County.

Richard H Clark Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was set up in memory of Dick Clark and is awarded to a full or part-time student continuing at Butte or transferring to a four-year institution. The recipient must be majoring in Astronomy, Chemistry, Geology, Meteorology or Physics. Applicants will have completed a minimum of 15 units at Butte College with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Service to the department such as tutoring, grading, or stockroom assistant will be looked upon favorably.

Robert P Glick, M.D. Memorial Scholarship

The Robert P Glick M.D. Memorial scholarship is awarded to a full-time Butte County resident pursuing a nursing degree who maintains a 3.0 GPA and demonstrates financial need. Financial need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid.

Rose and Mac McGinnis Memorial Scholarships

Established in memory of Rose and Mac McGinnis, this scholarship will be awarded to one full-time student who demonstrates financial need and is enrolled in the Cosmetology Program and one full-time student who is a member of the Native American Club who is nominated by their advisor. Financial need is determined by students who will be receiving any of the following for financial assistance: Federal Pell Grant, Cal Grant, or Chafee Grant.

Rozendaal Family Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a full-time Butte College student who attended Fairview High School, maintains a GPA of 3.0, and demonstrates financial need. Financial need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid.

The Tom and Anastacia Snyder Lando Career & Technical Scholarship is awarded to a full-time student with a cumulative 2.5 GPA enrolled in a career and technical education program.

Vesta Marilyn Holloway Memorial Nursing Scholarship

Preference shall be given to United States Military Veterans. Financial need is determined as those students who are receiving any form of financial aid.

Promise Scholarship Endowment
