Board elections shall be held in even-numbered years, consolidated with the General Election in Butte and Glenn Counties. Butte County will serve as the lead agency.

In May of each even-numbered year, the Board shall adopt the following resolutions, which shall then be forwarded to the Butte County Registrar of Voters requesting consolidation with the General Election:

Procedure in Case of Tie Vote

Once the election is certified by the County Clerk, a Certificate of Election and Oath of Office will be sent to the District for each elected Governing Board Member. If a Board Member runs unopposed in an area, his/her name will not appear on the ballot and he/she will be appointed in lieu of election.
