If the student member position becomes vacant by reason of the resignation or disqualification of an elected student member; by recall; or for any other reasons; the position will be filled in the following manner:

- If the Associated Students do not wish to call for a new election, the Board of Trustees President will be notified, in writing, of the vacancy and the Board will appoint a Student Trustee to fill the term until such time as the regular election takes place.
- If the Board of Trustees is to appoint a student trustee, the Board of Trustees will request the Associated Students to submit a list of not less than two, nor more than five, qualified candidates.
- A subcommittee of the Board, along with the Superintendent/President or designee, will interview the candidates.
- The subcommittee will recommend a candidate for appointment by the full Board.

The Student Member may be recalled in an election conducted in the same manner as the election to office. An election will be called upon presentation to the Superintendent/President of a petition signed by at least 20% of the students enrolled at the time of filing the petition. No recall election will be held if the petition is received within 60 days of a regularly scheduled election for student member.
