



AP 6801 Transportation of Sick or Injured Individuals

The District is not equipped and does not accept financial responsibility for transportation of sick or injured individuals from the campus to facilities elsewhere in the community. In the case of illness or injury occurring to an individual on campus, a College Police Department personnel may, at the Police Department personnel's discretion, transport the individual from the site to the Student Health Clinic if the individual's condition makes this action appropriate. College Police Department personnel responding to an emergency call on campus during regular hours (Monday – Friday) may consult with Student Health Clinic personnel when there is concern about the decision regarding transportation of the individual. If an emergency exists or the patient has compromised mobility, the Police Department personnel at the scene will make the decision to call an ambulance for transportation of a student or non-student to a hospital at the individual's expense.

Staff or faculty who provide transportation of sick or injured individuals to an off-campus destination do so at their own risk and as private individuals not as a representative of the District. The District does not provide liability coverage for such activities.
