



BP 2330 Quorum and Voting

A quorum of the Board will consist of a simple majority of its voting members. A meeting may be adjourned if less than a quorum is present.

Pursuant to Education Code §7200(d)(3) the Board will act by majority vote of all of the membership of the Board, except as noted below. The student trustee's advisory vote will be recorded but will not be included in determining quorum or the vote required to carry any measure. No action will be taken by secret ballot. The Board will publicly report any action taken in open session and the vote or abstention of each individual member present.

The following actions require a two-thirds majority of all members of the Board:

- Resolution of intention to sell or lease real property (except where a unanimous vote is required);
- Resolution of intention to dedicate or convey an easement;
- Resolution authorizing and directing the execution and delivery of a deed;
- Action to declare the District exempt from the approval requirements of a planning commission or other local land use body;
- Appropriation of funds from an undistributed reserve;
- Resolution to condemn real property;
- Resolution to pursue the authorization and issuance of bonds pursuant to paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Section 1 of Article XIII A of the California Constitution and subdivision (b) of Section 18 of Article XVI of the California Constitution.

The following actions require a unanimous vote of all members of the Board:

- Resolution authorizing a sale or lease of District real property to the state, any county, city, or to any other school or community college district;
- Resolution authorizing lease of District property under a lease for the production of gas.

There are no administrative procedures for this policy.
