Any audio or video recording of an open and public Board meeting made by or at the direction of the Board will be subject to inspection by members of the public in accordance with the California Public Records Act, Government Code §§7920.000, et seq. Any such recordings will be maintained in the Office of the Superintendent/President for at least thirty days following the taping or recording until the minutes of that Board meeting are approved.

Persons attending an open and public meeting of the Board may, at their own expense, record the proceedings with an audio or video tape recording or a still or motion picture camera, or may broadcast the proceedings. However, if the Board finds by a majority vote that the recording or broadcast cannot continue without noise, illumination, or obstruction of view that constitutes or would constitute a persistent disruption of the proceedings, any such person will be directed by the President of the Board to stop.

There are no administrative procedures for this policy.
