- Each year the Board will review the self-evaluation instrument and process. The instrument will incorporate criteria contained in board policy regarding board operations and board effectiveness.
- The criteria for the Board's self-evaluation will also include performance goals and objectives related to the District's and the Board's commitment to success for all students.
- All board members will be asked to complete the evaluation instrument and submit it to the Board Secretary.
- A summary of the evaluations will be presented at a special board session scheduled for that purpose. At that time the Board President will facilitate discussion of the self-evaluation results with all Board members and together the board will develop goals as needed for self-improvement. The superintendent/president will be invited to participate in both the evaluation and the special board session.
