The District shall maintain an organized program for students in intercollegiate athletics. The District will offer opportunities for participation in athletics equally to male, female, and transgender students consistent with state and federal law and California Community College Athletic Association standards.

Students who represent Butte College in athletic competition are expected to demonstrate good citizenship, sportsmanship, responsibility, honesty, and integrity on the field or court, on the campus, in the classroom, in the community, or in whatever venue their college activities occur. All Butte College students are subject to the Student Code of Conduct.

The Superintendent/President shall ensure that the athletics program complies with state and federal laws, the California Community College Athletic Association (CCCCAA) Constitution, Bylaws, and Sport Championship Handbooks, and appropriate Conference Constitution regarding student athlete participation.

The procedure for this policy is the Student Code of Conduct.
