BOARD POLICY

BP 6615 – Scheduled Maintenance Program

Reference: Education Code Section: 84660

The Superintendent/President or designee will submit to the Board and the System Office of the California Community Colleges an annual Scheduled Maintenance Program as required by law. The purpose of the Scheduled Maintenance Program is to address those facility maintenance problems that need major corrective action.

Primary consideration will be given to those projects that (1) meet safety requirements and correct hazardous conditions; (2) prevent substantially increased maintenance or replacement costs in the future, and (3) would result in facility /campus closure or danger to staff and students.
