

Academic Senate Taskforce for Software Approval

During the September 2, 2026, meeting, the Academic Senate asked the Executive Team to propose membership for an ATC task force.

Proposed areas of work

1. Map the current software-approval process, including all steps, responsible parties, and decision points.
2. Identify barriers contributing to delays, including procedural, communication, or structural challenges.
3. Develop recommendations to shorten and improve the decision-making timeline while maintaining compliance with college policies and state regulations

A call for nominations will be made for the task force, with members selected based on their experience and familiarity with software processes.
