1. Campus Strategic Documents Chart

Discussion of the charts was postponed to the December 13 meeting.

2. Draft Mission Statement

College Council reviewed the feedback solicited through the constituent groups via an online form. The group discussed the main areas of input (use of terms, length, and HSI designation) and re-examined the draft mission statement. College Council discussed the mission statement's audience as either guidance for employees or an outward-facing statement. College Council reached consensus that as an educational institution, it is acceptable to use newer concepts in the statement. The group also agreed that we live in and serve a rural area. College Council modified the draft mission statement, which will go to Leadership for review:

Butte College is a student-ready, rural community college that provides high-quality, accessible education and support. Our career and transfer pathways cultivate curiosity and critical thinking through instruction, workforce training, and the achievement of Associate degrees and certificates. As a Hispanic Serving Institution, Butte College affirms its commitment to equity for the diverse, intersectional communities we serve.
