#### 1. Institutional Research/Associated Students Artificial Intelligence Survey (Alan Burwell)

Classified Senate Vice President Burwell reported that the Associated Students approached Institutional Research for help with a student survey designed to gauge student feelings about artificial intelligence (AI) and how students use AI. He provided an overview of the survey questions. The survey will be distributed to students next week and Classified Senate Vice President Burwell will bring the results back to College Council. President Guleff recommended that survey results be reported to the President's Council on Innovation. She also suggested repeating the survey with another cohort of students. College Council discussed the contents of the survey, particularly the use of the word "plagiarism" and student perception of the concept.

#### 2. President's Council on Innovation (PCI) Membership

Academic Senate President Vickery reported that the Academic Senate selected Hesam Abedini, music department faculty, and Michael S. Smith, reference librarian, for the President's Council on Innovation (PCI). Both Abedini and Smith have backgrounds in AI. Senate wanted to have one instructional faculty member and one student development faculty member, particularly from the library given the role they play in supporting students' research. Academic Senate President Vickery concluded that the effort also yielded a list of volunteers who would be great candidates for the PCI's work groups.

Classified Senate Vice President Burwell reported that the Classified Senate selected Harry Saito, webmaster, and Rusty Bogart, lab tech senior, for the PCI. He noted that both are interested in tech issues and engaged in emerging technologies, but they have different perspectives.

College Council reviewed the MSC group's volunteers for the PCI and selected Maddie Bird, director of enterprise systems, and Bob White, dean of instruction, for the PCI.

Brad Zuniga will be the vice president on the PCI. The AS President will represent the student body on the council.

President Guleff indicated that the PCI will meet in May and then conduct a flex session in August. Regular meetings will start in the fall 2024 semester.

#### 3. Strategic Initiatives 1 & 2 Tracking

College Council reviewed every action item under strategic initiative one in the strategic plan, identifying the person or committee accountable for each action item and the person or committee responsible for each action item. They will continue with initiatives 2-4 at the next meeting.
