AA/AS Degree Requirements

- Minimum 60 semester units of degree applicable courses (numbered 1-199 or C1000-C2999)
- Overall grade point average of 2.0 (C average or better) in all degree applicable coursework (maximum of 8 semester units optionally graded credit [P] may be counted toward associate degree requirements)
- Minimum 12 semester units completed at Butte College (excludes Credit for Prior Learning units)
- Complete a major from the Butte College Catalog with a grade of C or better in each class
- Complete a minimum of 21 semester units of GE from the approved list according to the pattern outlined below
- Complete a minimum of 2 semester units from the Local Graduation Requirement courses in Self-Integration, Physical Education Activity, or Career Technical Education (CTE) Pathways Exploratory courses as outlined below
- Apply to graduate using the Graduation Overview tab in Self-Service (MyBC Portal) by the published deadline during the semester that all degree requirements will be met (see Admissions & Records for more information).

Waivers/Exemptions and Additional Information

- Any veteran with a DD-214 (credit for military service) is exempt from the local graduation requirement.
- The following programs are exempt from the local graduation requirement: Agriculture Business, Agriculture Science, Automotive/Diesel Technology (all), Construction Management, Drafting and CAD Technology, Environmental Horticulture, Law Enforcement Academy (all), Mechanized Agriculture, Natural Resources Management, Nursing and LVN (all), Paramedic, Respiratory Care, and Welding Technology.
- Any student who completes an associate degree using Cal-GETC, CSU GE Breadth, or IGETC, is exempt from the local graduation requirement.
- Any student who has previously completed an associate or baccalaureate degree at an institution of higher learning accredited by an entity formerly known as a Regional Accreditor is exempt from current GE requirements and the local graduation requirement.
- Comparable coursework at other accredited institutions may be substituted.
- Certification of coursework for Butte College general education will be honored provided that a course was on the college's approved Butte Local General Education Guide when it was completed.
